2. This form must be lodged by the registered officer of the party alongside completed form RO 50A at least 48 hours prior to the hour of nomination.
3. If applying for a group voting square on the ballot paper, either a completed form RO 50B or a completed form RO 50C should be lodged with these nomination forms.
4. How-to-vote cards for display in polling booths under section 66 of the *Electoral Act 1985* must be approved by the Electoral Commissioner and lodged with the Electoral Commission SA no later than 4 days after the day for nomination.
5. Nominations are accepted at face value. It is the responsibility of candidates to ensure they are qualified for election.
